- ☐ DAAC updates (Tiffany Morgan)
 - There are no new updates that pertain directly to Charter Schools.
- ☐ Staff Appreciation Week
 - 90s Theme
 - Underground staff spirit week
 - Organized by Alecia Martz and the Community Engagement Committee
 - \$14,000 expense
 - Lunch 2 times, coffee, breakfast, professional pictures, prizes, slushy machine, Kona Ice, decorations
 - Staff felt appreciated and were thankful, positive feedback
- ☐ PPR/Budget update
 - For the 2026-27 school year, Colorado lawmakers set the statewide average per-pupil funding to an estimated \$12,325 per student under the School Finance Act (SB26-023). This represents an increase of about \$449 per student from the previous year's funding levels.
- ☐ Hiring status
 - Still looking to hire a couple paraprofessional positions: Math Intervention, K Para
 - Hired: 6th Grade Math, Math Intervention, SpEd Teacher, .5 Counselor, Art, SpEd Para
- ☐ Summer work plans on the building
 - Due to the large construction projects during Spring Break (security cameras, outside speakers, 3 additional offices built, workroom moved), summer work is smaller than usual
 - Summer plans for interior painting and Koroseal in middle school hallway only, waxing, and window cleaning (approximately \$65,000)
- ☐ Award Recognition
 - Capturing Kids' Hearts National showcase school (3 years in a row)
 - Purple Star Award (military families)
 - 2026 Best of Springs: Courtney Hall (Elementary Educator - Bronze Winner)
 - Middle School of Distinction promotional video and banners - video will be produced by D49 and released to us this summer, filming has already been completed
- ☐ CMAS finalization
 - We will begin receiving some preliminary results this summer

- Parents will be sent CMAS results at the beginning of the 26-27 year
- ☐ End of year testing/next year's UIP
 - STAR and DIBELS End of Year testing was completed
 - Results were sent home to parents already
- ☐ Student placements for next year
 - Teachers have worked on these lists already
 - Changes may still come throughout the summer due to withdrawals or new enrollments
 - Teachers meet to look at student behavior, academic strengths and areas of need, Special Education plans, personality dynamics, boy/girl balance, and teacher instructional styles
 - Our goal is always to create balanced classrooms where all students can be successful and supported
